Public Consultation

The Ville de Montréal has mandated the Office de consultation publique de Montréal (OCPM) to hold a public consultation on the renovation of the playground and picnic areas in the « Clairière » sector, near Beaver Lake.

Presently, the playground equipment and picnic installations found in this part of the glade are outdated, unattractive and in insufficient numbers for such a popular site. This favourite sector has not been renovated since the early 60's.

The renovation of the playground area is necessary to make it more dynamic, attractive and safe. Plans call for relandscaping of pathways which are in very poor condition and adding new equipment in the picnic area. The project also calls for preserving the open nature of the glade while consolidating the vegetation all around to help with the creation of an ecological corridor for plants and animals.
