

The project calls for amendments to the Montréal Master Plan Complementary Document, and to the Planning By-law of the borough of Côte-des-Neiges-Notre-Dame-de-Grâce.

In terms of the Montréal Master Plan, the proposed amendments involve height limits, land coverage, and protected natural environments and green spaces.

The draft by-law aims primarily to recognize the height, land coverage and density of the new constructions, expansions and demolitions, and to structure the redevelopment of the site proposed in the institution's master plan.

The property is situated in the historic and natural borough of Mont-Royal. As a result of the adoption of the Mount Royal Master Protection and Enhancement Plan, strict rules prevent the expansion of institutional properties on the mountain without an amendment to the Montréal Master Plan and the adoption of a by-law under section 89.5 of the Charter of Ville de Montréal.


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THE PROJECT

The project submitted by collège Notre-Dame defines its wish to upgrade and expand its playing fields and leisure spaces for students. At the same time, the collège is seeking to repurpose the outdoor space surrounding the main pavilion with a view to improving the landscape quality of the site.

The changes requested involve the redevelopment of the Sacré-Coeur yard to include a sports and cultural centre, the expansion of the B wing, the construction of a walkway between the Notre-Dame and Lefebvre pavilions, the redevelopment of the drop-off area, the demolition of the Renaud house and the old coal shed, the construction of a storage space and the installation of a synthetic surface on the Reine-Marie playing field.
