The Pierrefonds Ouest project should not be undertaken. The land has great ecological value, and is part of a larger network of green spaces in the area. This network includes the l'Anse a l'Orme corridor, Cap St Jaques park, Bois-de-Liesse agricultural park, McGill forests and the Morgan Arboretum. This network is unique on the island of Montreal; each elements increases the values of the other ones by their proximity and ability to support a wider range of wildlife, to name a few of the advantages. The City of Montreal needs these spaces in order to stay true to its promise of protecting a sufficient percentage of green space within its territory.
