Proposed Cultural Development Policy for the City of Montréal



THE PROPOSAL

The proposed *Cultural Development Policy* focuses on five major axes:

1. making culture available to all residents;
2. improving the “cultural quality” of the living environment;
3. supporting arts and culture;
4. promoting Montréal;
5. ensuring the co-operation of the various players.

The Office de consultation publique de Montréal Commission responsible for consulting the population on the draft *Cultural Development Policy* believes that further reflection is required on conditions promoting the necessary co-operation among players, prior to the hearing of briefs.

In this context, three thematic workshops, corresponding to the axes around which the policy revolves, are offered to the public in order to further define questions of co-operation related to the areas of intervention, and to the orientations stemming therefrom. The objective is to promote discussion among the members of the various groups involved.

The thematic workshops will allow participants to interact in order to better define the opportunities and constraints involved in partnerships.
