

Public Consultation

1. Sessions for the presentation of briefs and oral presentations

Individuals and organizations wishing to do so may submit a brief to the commission. There are three ways to express opinions to the commission:

- A) Submitting a written brief and presenting it at a meeting
- B) Submitting a written brief without presenting it at a meeting
- C) Verbally expressing an opinion at a meeting without submitting a brief

Procedure to follow:

A) Submitting a written brief and presenting it at a meeting

- 1. Register by phone at 514 872-8510 before **October 7**th, **2010**, **4:00** p.m.
- 2. Send us your brief in electronic format (Word or PDF) by e-mail at the following address: gvezina.p@ville.montreal.qc.ca before **October 7th**, **2010**, **4:00 p.m**.
- 3. Fill out the Online Registration Form or fax it to 514 872-2556

B) Submitting a written brief without presenting it at a meeting

- 1. Send us your brief in electronic format (Word or PDF) by e-mail at the following address: gvezina.p@ville.montreal.qc.ca before **October 7**th, **2010, 4:00 p.m.**

C) Verbally expressing an opinion at a meeting without submitting a brief

Hard copies: If the brief has <u>20</u> or more pages, you must send <u>eight</u> hard copies of the brief to the following address:

The briefs are made public at the consultation meetings and are posted on the OCPM Web site the day after the last session for the presentation of briefs.

To avoid the dissemination of <u>personal or confidential information</u>—address, telephone number, e-mail address, etc.—individuals and organizations who submit a brief must enter this information on the <u>Online Registration Form</u>, which will be appended to their brief. If the brief contains copyright-protected documents, such as newspaper or magazine articles, a reproduction license must be attached.

Any brief containing personal information or copyright-protected documents without the proper reproduction license will not be posted on the Office Web site. However, it will be distributed to members of the commission.

The briefs must be written in a manner <u>respectful</u> of the other participants, and must not contain comments that are detrimental to their dignity, honour or reputation.
