

The 'disgraceful exit' of the English after the burning of the Parliament building in the Old Port in 1849 and varied other incidents, including removing nuns from the convents and executing them, and burning records and deeds of sale, are not of the highest regard.





Is there a sense of 'Architectural Integrity' and 'Architectural Continuity' to reflect this notion of 'transcendence of time'...??!


And finally, does anyone even care ...who works in the different Municipal committeesor is even educatedregarding Architectural & Urban priorities in making 'ethical decisions'
