Wetlands have tremendous value ecologically for preservation of different species of birds and amphibians. Many breeds of birds in the L'Anse à l'Ormes depend on access to survival nest on the ground

Montreal decided last year to increase the area of green space from 6% to 10%. The 280 hectares of wetlands of L'Anse à l'Ormes is a huge part of Montreal's 6%.
