Reminder - Ville de Montréal will create a new nature-park, and plans to provide a North-South link for pedestrians and cyclists








MY DREAM PARK

Respondents from all over the island of Montréal






Questions about habits related to cycling as well as about the type of structure preferred for the North-South link

Q: "Do you cycle in Montréal?"






The majority of bicycle use is for trips related to leisure and the outdoors

N: 2,014 respondents, several answers possible






Bicycle use beyond the summer season

N: 2,014 respondents






Respondents are aware of the North-South link project

Q: "Have you heard of the North-South bicycle link, also called the 'dalle-parc' project by the media?"



The North-South link would improve trips for more than half of respondents


Q: "Will this future link improve your trips?"






The majority of respondents would use the North-South link occasionally

Q: "What do you think you will use the North-South link for?"






In winter, respondents would use the link on foot or would take advantage of its packed trails for winter sports

Q: "What do you think you will use the North-South link for in the winter?"








Respondents hope the North-South link will improve the attractiveness of landscapes in the city

> "If I can dream, the link would become a tourist attraction"




"It's an important project to mitigate climate change (bicycling) and for adaptation (green infrastructure). Thank-you!"

"Let's be proud to be imaginative with an innovative spectacular architectural project that will be unique, in which the vegetation can provide a home for many birds and butterflies during the summer."


